### The "basics" for Middle School (grades 6-8)

- Ring Binder with sections (8-10 dividers)

- Paper atlas that fits into a notebook (7th graders)
- Dictionary to keep at school (6th & 7th graders)

### MATH

#### \*\*\*Students taking Algebra I, Algebra II, Algebra III, Pre-Calculus, & AP Calculus:

- TI-84-Plus Calculator (Texas Instruments) - required
- The textbooks are based on the use of this calculator, and we will spend considerable time in class using this advanced graphing calculator.
- It is also approved for use on SAT and AP exams.

2-5 playable reeds in case at all times.

Reed keeper

Cork grease

Cleaning cloth - soft, cotton

**Brass players:**

Slide oil or grease for Trombones

Valve oil for all other brass

Straight Mute (Trumpets only)

**Percussion:**

Pair of snare sticks (at school)

Snare drum/bell set (at home usually)
