AP Studio ART & Advanced ART Supply List

There will be \$10 invoiced on your account to help offset some of the higher costs of supplies for these advanced art courses. Be prepared also to be invoiced for the Studio Art AP Exam at the appropriate time.

These items can be found at discount stores (such as Wal-Mart & Dollar General Stores)
(Please look for older, used items from prior years before purchasing any.)

- 1 Shoe Box size ART BOX with Lid—cardboard or plastic, not TOO large please, but large enough for ALL art supplies to stay in art room)
- Sketchbook (Just keep adding to one you already use OR I'll provide a new one)
- 1/2" wide BLACK 3 Ring Binder filled w/5 Tab Dividers, Loose Leaf Lined Paper, Graph Paper & Tracing Paper
- White Out for Ink
- Black Ink pen--Choose One for ink drawings: BIC z4 Needle Point Roller 0.7, OR Pentel EnerGel Liquid Gel Ink Metal Tip 0.7 mm, OR Sarasa Zebra 0.7
- 1 Roll of 1" Blue Painter's Tape
- Colored Pencils AND Washable Markers
- 1 Pencil Compass AND 6" Ruler or longer (if it fits in your art box)
- 1 Black Fine Point Permanent Sharpie or Ultra Fine Point
- Personal Flash Drive** for Your Research & Documentation of Progress
- 1 Roll of Paper Towels & Pack of Wet Wipes

(If watercolor becomes your specialty, you may need to invest in tubes of watercolors)
- Acrylic Paints: Cadmium Red Medium, Ultramarine Blue, Yellow Medium, Titanium White, Ivory Black plus other special colors you Prefer working with (It is OK if you purchase a set already boxed & there are slightly different names.)
- Paint Palette with Lid (Some are just 99 cents at Hobby Lobby)
- Small Set of Blending Stumps or Tortillons in various sizes

As you begin to discover your specialty, you may want to purchase other items, too.
