

OPS Third Grade Supply List 2020-21

1 sturdy plastic shoebox with lid just large enough to hold these items:

- (3) boxes of 24 crayons
- 1 pair of scissors
- (24) no. 2 pencils- sharpened
- (1) box of 8 or 10 washable markers
- (1) box of Crayola skinny markers
- (2) highlighters
- (1) ruler with centimeters and inches
- (8) large glue sticks (or 12 small ones)
- (1) set of Crayola watercolor paints
- (1) box of colored pencils

Other items needed:

Lunch box or container

Sturdy book bag or backpack (no rolling backpacks)

(2) cloth **jumbo** book covers for the math and reading books – (they are large books)

1 pencil box (8" X 5")

1 Lab Coat (Order from Amazon - Natural Uniforms Real Children's Lab Coat for School Projects)

There is no need to write your child's name on the following- Labels will be provided:

- (5) one subject spiral (wide ruled) notebooks
- (2) plastic pocket folders with prongs
- (5) pocket folders without prongs
- (2) wide ruled composition notebooks
- (1) 1 ½ inch binder
- (1) Clipboard (with child's name)
- (1) set of headphones
- (1) white poster board (This will be their art portfolio for art class)
- Painting smock or shirt

Supply list for 3rd grade Spanish

(1) – 1 inch 3-ring binder with lined writing paper and (4) pocket dividers. (Label the binder “World Languages”)

(1) - Language dictionary (from Barnes and Noble = Langenscheidt Spanish-English / English Spanish for the Spanish students PLEASE DO NOT SUBSTITUTE)

Supply list for 3rd grade German

1 large composition book - ruled Notebook- (11 ¾ by 8 ¼ usually found at Office Depot or Office Max)
