

## **Supply List**

### **Grade 2**

DO NOT LABEL the following items:

- 1 box 16 crayons
- 1 16-color set of watercolor paints
- 1 set of watercolor brushes in a variety of sizes
- 2 boxes of colored pencils (both must include primary colors)
- 2 pairs of children's scissors
- 2 rulers (with inches and centimeters on each)-transparent, no designs
- 1 box 8 magic markers (primary colors)

\*Place the above items in a LARGE sturdy plastic shoebox with lid.

LABEL the shoebox with your child's name and place in your child's cubby on Orientation Day.

- 8 glue sticks
- 1 four-ounce bottle of liquid school glue
- 4 block erasers (pink)
- 48 Ticonderoga (yellow) No. 2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- 3 white poster boards
- 2 black and white marble composition books
- 2 (1/2" binders) round ring clear-view white binders
- 1 ream (150 pages) notebook paper

- 1 clipboard (small clip)
- 2 sturdy pocket folders with design on cover for privacy folders (no plastic)
- 2 blue heavy-duty plastic pocket folders, no brads

- 1 small 5"x 8" colored plastic pencil box (97¢ or less @ Walmart)
- Painting shirt-Dad's t-shirt works best--no button shirts, aprons, or smocks
- Headphones in a baggie (for Computer Lab)
- Small Umbrella to keep in cubbie to use when we walk to gym in the rain
- No metal water bottles, plastic only
