HISTORY & LOCATION

Rosemary Moore founded the Village School in 1992 based on the work of the British educator Charlotte Mason. Mrs. Moore desired to create a school where students would engage directly with nature and the classics in literature, art, and music. Since its founding, the school has grown to become Oakbrook Prep, a rigorous college preparatory school with an enrollment of more than 450 students on a beautiful 38 acre campus in Spartanburg, South Carolina. Oakbrook families represent more than 40 countries by birth or nationality. Students participate in international travel, missions, and exchange programs with Germany, China, and Spanish-speaking countries.

Oakbrook is accredited by AdvancEd and the South Carolina Association of Independent Schools and hold memberships with South Association for College Admission Counseling and College Board.

CLASS OF 2017

The Class of 2017 was comprised of 41 students, 95% of whom matriculated to four year colleges or universities. The diversity of this class included 2.5% African American, 2.5% Pacific Islander, 5% Hispanic, 7% Asian, and 83% Caucasian students. The Class of 2017 was Oakbrook's twelfth graduating and was offered more than \$3 million in scholarships.
